1. What is the State PSC Real Test?

Morning Shift: General Studies (GS)

Evening Shift: Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT)

Unlike regular mock tests, the Real Test closely replicates the actual PSC exam experience, from registration to the test environment. It's conducted at centers similar to real exam venues, offering an authentic exam-day simulation.

5. Who can take the State PSC Real Test?

The test is designed specifically for students preparing for the MPPSC 2025 exams. This test provides a valuable final assessment opportunity for aspirants aiming to benchmark their readiness.

6. How do I register for the Real Test?

Registration can be completed online, with detailed instructions available on our official website or app.

7. Where will the Real Test be conducted?

The test will be held in select cities across Madhya Pradesh, at centers similar to those used in the actual PSC exams. Current locations include Indore and Gwalior.

8. How do I know the exact location of my test center?

The exact location will be specified on your admit card. Test centers will be within the city you selected during registration.

9. What is the fee for the Real Test?

The registration fee is ₹49. This fee is intended to attract serious aspirants and create a highly competitive environment.

10. What is the medium of the Real Test?

The Real Test is bilingual to cater to regional language preferences:

- MPPSC: Conducted in both Hindi and English.

11. How will this test help improve my score?

The Real Test provides an authentic exam environment with similar time pressures and question types, helping students identify areas for improvement before the actual exam. This preparation can boost overall performance and confidence.

12. Will I get detailed feedback after the test?

Yes, each participant will receive a performance analysis highlighting strengths, areas for improvement, and a comparison with other test-takers across the state.

13. Can I take the Real Test multiple times?

The Real Test is offered as a one-time opportunity close to the actual exam date to provide a genuine benchmark of your preparedness. However, similar practice tests may be available for regular prep.

You should bring a valid ID and admit card to the test center. Additional details will be provided along with the admit card.
